Once again renowned Judges from Scotland & England are attending also from the North and South of Ireland are officiating.

The 'Augher Co-op Food Hall' which was a huge success in Year 2009 is again running and is full to capacity. It will be opened on Tuesday 27th July at 7.00 pm by our guest speaker Mr. John Thompson President of the Ulster Farmers Union This is attended by our Judges, representatives of local Hotels, Restaurants and local food retailers who will meet the food stand-holders and talk with them about their products.

In association with the Department of Agriculture and Rural Development's Regional Food Programme Paula McIntyre, the chef from BBC Radio Ulster's popular Saturday morning magazine programme, will be in attendance on Show Day. Her expertise and easy manner should be a great attraction and she will be assisted in cooking tasty dishes by students from the three Secondary Schools in the Valley.

There will as usual be a wide selection of products available for sampling and for sale in the Food Hall, from specialist meats to delicious cakes and jams, from local cheeses to fresh fruit and vegetables. There Should be something for everyone.

Dungannon & South Tyrone Borough Council are once again hosting a reception for Judges and Special Guests on the evening prior to the Show, Toilet Facilities, and Safety Barriers as well as building two connecting bridges over the River Blackwater for the use of Spectators on show day.

Trade Exhibitors sell a wide range of merchandise so spectators from the farming community can view the most up-to-date machinery, cars and products and avail of special show-day offers. There are special awards of Tyrone Crystal for Best Trade Stands, most attractive in Food Hall and most outstanding in Craft Marquee.

Safety is of paramount importance and organisers hope for an accident-free Show. Spectators can have the choice of watching Horse and Pony Showing and Show-Jumping in Mr Jack Johnston's field. Sheep Showing, Goat Showing, Food Hall, Craft Marquee, School Children's and Adults Arts and Crafts, Floral and Horticulture display and Home Baking etc in Mr. Stephen Finlay's field, Cattle Showing in the Playing Field and Dog Showing alongside the Trade Exhibits in the Football Field.

Traffic diversions will be in operation on Show morning to facilitate the free flow of traffic and details will be published in the local press at a later date.

As Clogher Valley Show is an enjoyable day out for all the family there will be ongoing entertainment as well as other amusements and side shows for children.

Prize-winners' Parade takes place at approximately 3.00 pm in the Cattle Field.

We hope to have fine weather on 28th July so that everyone can enjoy a fun-filled family day out.
