- Class 415** - Any item of 2-dimensional Art/Design confined to pupils attending Secondary School.
- Class 416** - Any item of 3 dimensional Art/Design confined to pupils attending Secondary School.
- Class 417** - Any item of textile art, including needlework, confined to Primary 6 and 7 pupils
NB - The McKenna (Kilrudden) Cup will be presented to the winner.

- Class 418** - Any item of textile art, including needlework, confined to Primary 4 and 5 pupils.
- Class 419** - Any item of 3D art/design, confined to Foundation Stage pupils - group effort
- Class 420** - Any item of 3D art/design, confined to Foundation Stage pupils - individual work.
- Class 421** - Picture in any medium, confined to Foundation Stage pupils - Maximum A3 paper.
- Class 422** - Picture in any medium, confined to Key Stage 1 pupils. Maximum A3 paper. Theme - "Minibeasts "

- Class 423** - Picture in any medium, confined to Key Stage1 pupils. Maximum A3 paper. Theme - " A Jungle Animal ".

- Class 424** - Any item of 3D art/design, confined to Key Stage1 pupils - group effort.
- Class 425** - Any item of 3D art/design, confined to Key Stage 1 pupils - individual work.
- Class 426** - Picture in any medium, confined to Key Stage 2 pupils. Maximum A3 paper. Theme - "An Illustration of a Fable by Aesop "

- Class 427** - Picture in any medium, confined to Key Stage 2 pupils. Maximum A3 paper. Theme - " A Character from a Myth or Legend ".

- Class 428** - Any item of 3 D Art/Design confined to primary 5 pupils - individual work
- Class 429** - Any item of 3 D Art/Design confined to primary 6 pupils - individual work
- Class 430** - Any item of 3 D Art/Design confined to primary 7 pupils - individual work
- Class 431** - Any item of 3 D Art/Design confined to Key Stage 2 pupils - group effort.
- Class 432** - A design on A4 paper (must NOT be a repeating pattern) confined to Foundation Stage pupils.
- Class 433** - A design on A4 paper (must NOT be a repeating pattern) confined to Key Stage 1 pupils.
- Class 434** - A design on A4 paper (must NOT be a repeating pattern) confined to Primary 5 pupils.
- Class 435** - A design on A4 paper (must NOT be a repeating pattern) confined to Primary 6 pupils.
- Class 436** - A design on A4 paper (must NOT be a repeating pattern) confined to Primary 7 pupils.
- Class 437** - Handwriting-print script-maximum 8 lines of poetry or prose confined to Foundation Stage pupils.

Class 438 - Handwriting- any style-maximum 12 lines of poetry or prose confined to Key Stage 1 pupils.

NB The "Adam Lambert Memorial Cup" will be awarded to the winner.

Class 439 - Handwriting - Joined - maximum 12 lines of poetry or prose confined to Primary 5 pupils.

Class 440 - Handwriting - Joined - maximum 12 lines of poetry or prose confined to Primary 6 pupils.

Class 441 - Handwriting - Joined - maximum 12 lines of poetry or prose confined to Primary 7 pupils.

N.B. The Noel Mulligan Memorial Cup will be awarded to the winner

N.B. The entries for the following Creative Writing classes must be posted with entry forms as they are judged prior to the show.

Class 442 - Creative Writing. An original story. Confined to primary 3 pupils.

Class 443 - Creative Writing. An original story. Confined to primary 4 & 5 pupils.

Class 444 - Creative Writing. An original story. Confined to primary 6 & 7 pupils.

Class 445 - Creative Writing. An original poem. Confined to primary 3 pupils.

Class 446 - Creative Writing. An original poem. Confined to primary 4 and 5 pupils.

Class 447 - Creative Writing. An original poem. Confined to primary 6 and 7 pupils
