Confined to pupils attending Secondary and Primary Schools.

Each School is responsible for displaying their own exhibits.

Entry Fee 50p

Exhibits in Classes for Hand Writing and Creative Writing must be sent to the Secretary when sending in entries

Secondary School classes

- Class 428** - Any item of 2-dimensional Art/Design confined to Secondary School students.
 - Class 429** - Any item of 3 dimensional Art/Design confined to Secondary School students.
 - Class 430** - Any item of Design and Technology confined to Secondary School students.
 - Class 431** - Any item of textile art, including needlework, Confined to GCSE and A-Level students.
- Foundation Stage (P1 and P2) classes

N.B. The entries for the following Hand Writing and Creative Writing classes must be posted with entry forms as they are judged prior to the show.

- Class 432** - Any item of 3D art/design, confined to Foundation Stage pupils - group effort
- Class 433** - Any item of 3D art/design, confined to Foundation Stage pupils - individual work.
- Class 434** - Picture in any medium, confined to Foundation Stage pupils - Maximum A3 paper - Theme "The Farm.
- Class 435** - A printing design, confined to Foundation Stage pupils. Maximum A3 paper.
- Class 436** - Handwriting-print script-maximum 8 lines of poetry or prose confined to Foundation Stage pupils.

Key Stage 1 (P3 and P4) classes

N.B. The entries for the following Hand Writing and Creative Writing classes must be posted with entry forms as they are judged prior to the show.

- Class 437** - Any item of textile art, including needlework, confined to Key Stage 1 pupils
- Class 438** - Any item of 3D art/design, confined to Key Stage 1 pupils - group effort.
- Class 439** - Any item of 3D art/design, confined to Key Stage 1 pupils - individual work.
- Class 440** - Picture in any medium, confined to Key Stage 1 pupils. Maximum A3 paper. Theme - "Traditional Stories and Tales".
- Class 441** - A symmetrical design, confined to Key Stage 1 pupils. Maximum A3 paper.
- Class 442** - Handwriting- any style-maximum 12 lines of poetry or prose confined to Key Stage 1 pupils.

(NB The "Adam Lambert Memorial Cup" will be awarded to the winner).

- Class 443** - Creative Writing - an original story with the opening line "Once upon a time..." Confined to primary 3 pupils.
- Class 444** - Creative Writing - an original story with the opening line "I knew there was something strange about my teacher..." Confined to primary 4 pupils.
- Class 445** - Creative Writing - an original poem. Confined to primary 3 pupils.
- Class 446** - Creative Writing - an original poem. Confined to primary 4 pupils.

Class 447 - Create and design a party invitation using any ICT package.
Key stage 2 (P5, P6 and P7)

N.B. The entries for the following Hand Writing and Creative Writing classes must be posted with entry forms as they are judged prior to the show.

Class 448 - Any item of textile art, including needlework, confined to Key Stage 2 pupils
(NB - The McKenna (Kilrudden) Cup will be presented to the winner).

Class 449 - Any item of 3 D Art/Design confined to Key Stage 2 pupils - group effort.

Class 450 - Any item of 3 D Art/Design confined to primary 5 pupils - individual work

Class 451 - Any item of 3 D Art/Design confined to primary 6 pupils - individual work

Class 452 - Any item of 3 D Art/Design confined to primary 7 pupils - individual work

Class 453 - Picture in any medium, confined to Key Stage 2 pupils. Maximum A3 paper - related to school's World Around Us topic.

Class 454 - A design using tessellation or tiling patterns confined to Key Stage 2 pupils. Maximum A3 paper

Class 455 - Handwriting - Joined - maximum 12 lines of poetry or prose confined to Primary 5 pupils.

Class 456 - Handwriting - Joined - maximum 12 lines of poetry or prose confined to Primary 6 pupils.

Class 457 - Handwriting - Joined - maximum 12 lines of poetry or prose confined to Primary 7 pupils.

(N.B. The Noel Mulligan Memorial Cup will be awarded to the winner).

Class 458 - Creative Writing - an original story with the opening line, "The Strangest thing happened to me..." Confined to primary 5 pupils.

Class 459 - Creative Writing - an original story with the opening line "As I put the mask over my face I had the strangest feeling..." Confined to primary 6 & 7 pupils.

Class 460 - Creative Writing - an original poem Confined to primary 5 pupils.

Class 461 - Creative Writing - an original poem. Confined to primary 6 and 7 pupils
(N.B. The Margaret Mulligan Cup will be awarded to the winner)

Class 462 - Use a suitable word processing or desktop publishing package to create an A4 poster related to a class topic.

Class 463 - Digital photograph taken on school premises using the school camera. Theme " Wildlife".
