THE CONNEMARA THREE YEAR OLD FILLY ALL IRELAND CHAMPIONSHIP

RULES AND CONDITIONS

- 1. This championship is confined to Registered Connemara Three year Old Fillies. The progeny of Registered Connemara Sire & Registered Connemara Dam.
- Exhibitors In both the Qualifier and the Final must have the CPBS Passport ready for inspection prior to entry to the judging ring. Failure to comply with this rule will lead to immediate disqualification.
- 3. More than one Filly may be selected at any qualifying Show to compete in the Final providing the judges & the ISA agree the standard of warrant such selection.
- 4. One of the Judges at the final must be from CPBS judges list.
- 5. Ponies qualified for the final are not to enter any other clases at Ballinasloe Show.
- 6. Plaiting of manes and tails is not allowed for qualifier or final.
- 7. The Qualifying Exhibitor must fill out their own Qualifying Card at each Qualifying Show.
- 8. These rules should be read in conjunction with the I.S.A. rules.

CLASS 55: CONNEMARA IN HAND CHAMPIONSHIP

1st & 2nd Prize Winners from classes 51, 53 & 54, are eligible to compete (The Glenburn Perpetual Cup)

MOUNTAIN & MOORLAND IN HAND

Entry Fee: £12 unless otherwise stated.

No child under 16 years on 1st January of current year may lead a pony in any of the M&M In Hand,

Breeding and Young Stock Classes.

In the event of insufficient entries, classes may be suitably amalgamated.

CLASS 56: MIXED SMALL BREEDS ANY AGE IN-HAND

CLASS 57: MIXED LARGE BREEDS ANY AGE IN-HAND

CLASS 58: MOUNTAIN & MOORLAND IN-HAND CHAMPIONSHIP

1st & 2nd prize winners from classes 56 & 57 are eligible to compete

HUNTER PONY BREEDING IN HAND

Entry Fee: £12 unless otherwise stated.

No child under 16 on 1st January in the current year may lead an exhibit in any of the Breeding and Youngstock Classes

Hunter Ponies not exceeding 153cms must be registers in the N.P.S. Riding Pony Stud Book, Register or Appendix, the GSB, the AHSB the AASB or registered in the main body of their Respective Mountain & Moorland Stud Books. Part-Breds are not eligible unless entered in the NPS stud Book, Register or Appendix.

CLASS 59: SHOW HUNTER PONY STALLION, MARE OR GELDING

4 year old and over. In Hand

WELSH PONIES

Entry Fee: £12 unless otherwise stated.

Location: Ring 2

CLASS 60: WELSH SECTION A OR B

CLASS 61: WELSH SECTION C OR D

CLASS 62: WELSH SECTION CHAMPIONSHIP

1st & 2nd Prize Winners from classes 60 & 61 are eliable to compete

SHETLAND PONIES

Entry Fee: £12 unless otherwise stated.

Animals entered in these classes must be entered or eligible for entry in the Shetland Pony Stud Book. Ponies of 3 years of age or under must not exceed 40 inches in height and ponies, 4 years of age,

must not exceed 42 inches in height

CLASS 63: ENTIRE MALE OR GELDING 4 YEARS OLD OR OVER

CLASS 64: BROODMARE, 4 YEARS OLD OR OVER WITH FOAL AT FOOT

OR STINTED

CLASS 65: COLT OR FILLY FOAL

CLASS 66: COLT, GELDING OR FILLY, 1, 2 OR 3 YEARS OLD.

CLASS 67: JUNIOR CHAMPIONSHIP

1st & 2nd Prize Winners in classes 65 & 66 are eligible to compete. (The Glenkee perpetual Cup.)

CLASS 68: SHETLAND OVERALL CHAMPIONSHIP

1st & 2nd Prize Winners in Classes 63 & 64 plus Junior Champion & Reserve are eligible to compete (The Aughentaine Perpetual Cup.)

YOUNG HANDLERS IN HAND PONIES

Entry Fee: £12 unless otherwise stated.

- Young Handler classes are to be judged on the handler's presentation and showing technique and is awarded to the handler, not the pony.
- Handlers of ponies competing in Young Handler classes MUST wear a secured current BSI standard Skull / Riding Hat.
- Only Ponies to be shown in Young Handler Classes are Mares or Geldings 4 years old & over, not
 exceeding 153cms any breed
- No Stallions, Geldings or Foals to be shown

CLASS 69: JUNIOR YOUNG HANDLER IN HAND

Exhibitors to be age between 7 & 11 years old

CLASS 70: SENIOR YOUNG HANDLER IN HAND

Handlers to be between the age of 12 & 16 years old

RIDDEN PONIES

Entry Fee: £12 unless otherwise stated.

Riding Ponies not exceeding 148cms must be registered in the N.P.S. Riding Pony Stud Book, Register or Appendix, the GSB, the AHSB the AASB or registered in the main body of their Respective M&M Stud Books. Part-Breds are not eligible unless entered in the NPS stud Book, Register or Appendix.

Location: Ring 3

CLASS 71: LEAD REIN CLASS

For Ponies, Mares or Geldings, 4 years old and over, not exceeding 122 cms, suitable for and to be ridden by riders who have not attained their 7th birthday on 1st January in the current year. Ponies must be shown in snaffle bridles. They must be led by an adult and should be on a loose rein and will be required to trot. The attendant must affix the lead rein to the noseband on which it must remain while the pony is in the ring. The rein must go directly from the bit to the rider's hand, with no extra aid or attachment to or on the saddle.

CLASS 72: FIRST RIDDEN PONY CLASS

For ponies, mares or geldings, 4 years old and over, not exceeding 122 cms, suitable for and to be ridden by riders who have not attained their 10th birthday on 1st January. Ponies must be shown in snaffle bridles. Riders in this class may not compete in any other show pony class at the same show. This restriction does not apply to the pony. No cantering allowed except for individual performances. Ponies must leave the ring at the walk or trot.

CLASS 73: OPEN 128 CMS RIDING CLASS

For ponies, mares or geldings, 4 years old and over, not exceeding 128 cms, suitable for and to be ridden by riders who have not attained their 13th birthday on 1st January in the current year (Wigmore Perpetual Cup)

CLASS 74: OPEN 138 CMS RIDING CLASS

For ponies, mares or geldings, 4 years old and over, exceeding 128 cms, but not exceeding 138 cms, suitable for and to be ridden by riders who have not attained their 15th birthday on 1st January in the current year.

CLASS 75: OPEN 148 CMS RIDING CLASS

For ponies, mares or geldings, 4 years old and over, exceeding 138 cms, but not exceeding 148 cms, suitable for and to be ridden by riders who have not attained their 17th birthday on 1st January in the current year.

CLASS 76: CHAMPION RIDING PONY AND RESERVE

1st and 2nd Prize Winners in Classes 71 to 75 are eligible to compete

MOUNTAIN & MOORLAND RIDDEN PONIES

Entry Fee: £12 unless otherwise stated.

Location: Ring 3

CLASS 77: M&M LEAD REIN CLASS

Mare or Gelding, 4 years old and over, not exceeding 122cms. To be led by an attendant and shown in a snaffle bridle. Lead Rein to be attached to the noseband only. Rider not to have attained their 9th birthday before 1st January in the current year.

CLASS 78: M&M FIRST RIDDEN CLASS

Mare or Gelding, 4 years old and over, not exceeding 128cms. To be shown in any suitable bridle. Rider not to have attained their 12th birthday before 1st January in the current year

CLASS 79: NOVICE M&M SMALL BREEDS RIDDEN

Stallions Mares and geldings four years old and over, registered in the main body of their respective Breed Society Stud Book. Must be ridden with snaffle bit. Ponies never to have won a first place of £5 or more in any M&M Open Ridden Class

CLASS 80: NOVICE M&M LARGE BREEDS RIDDEN

Stallions Mares and geldings 4 years old and over, registered in the main body of their respective Breed Society Stud Book. Must be ridden with snaffle bit Ponies never to have won a first place of £5 or more in any M&M Open Ridden Class

CLASS 81: OPEN M&M SMALL BREEDS RIDDEN

4 years and over, Stallion, Mare, or Gelding – Registered in the main body of their respective Breed Society Stud Book. Riders can be any age.

CLASS 82: OPEN M&M LARGE BREEDS RIDDEN

Stallion, Mare, or Gelding 4 years and over. Registered in the main body of their respective Breed Society Stud Book. Rider any age

CLASS 83: MOUNTAIN & MOORLAND RIDDEN CHAMPIONSHIP

1st and 2nd prize winners from Classes 77 till 82 are eligible to compete

CONNEMARA RIDDEN PONIES

Entry Fee: £12 unless otherwise stated.

CLASS 84: RIDDEN CONNEMARA PONY MARE 4 YEARS OLD AND OVER

CLASS 85: RIDDEN CONNEMARA PONY STALLION OR GELDING 4 YEARS OLD AND OVER

1st & 2nd Prize Winners in classes 84 & 85 are eligible to compete

Family Pony Classes from 88 to 93 will run in order in Ring 6 at 10AM Sharp These classes are not showing classes and will be judged on temperament and reliability Ponies entered in any Show Class <u>will not</u> be eligible for the Family Pony Classes (Organised by Mrs Gail Boyd)

CLASS 88: FAMILY PONY CLASS LEAD REIN

Ponies up to 13.3 h.h. For Riders 8 years old and under. This is not a show class and will be judged on temperament and reliability. Ponies entered in the show classes are not eligible for this class. Ponies must be led. (The Edward William Boyd Irwin Cup)

CLASS 89: FAMILY PONY CLASS UNLED

Ponies up to 13.3 h.h. For Riders 8 years old and under. This is not a show class and will be judged on temperament and reliability. Ponies entered in the show classes are not eligible for this class. Ponies must not be led. (The Boyd Perpetual Trophy)

CLASS 90: FAMILY PONY LEAD REIN

Ponies up to 13.3 h.h. For Riders aged between 9-13 years old. This is not a show class and will be judged on temperament and reliability. Ponies entered in the show classes are not eligible for this class. Ponies must be led. (The Rehill McKeown Cup)

CLASS 91: FAMILY PONY UNLED

Ponies up to 13.3 h.h. For Riders aged between 9-13 years old. This is not a show class and will be judged on temperament and reliability. Ponies entered in the show classes are not eligible for this class. Ponies must be not be led.(The Ballyrenan Cup)

CLASS 92: OPEN FAMILY PONY CLASS

Ponies up to 148cms. Jumps not exceeding 50cms. For exhibitors up to 17 years old This is not a show class and will be judged on temperament and reliability. Ponies entered in the show classes are not eligible for this class.(Dungannon & South Tyrone Borough Council Cup)

CLASS 93: FAMILY PONY CHAMPIONSHIP

1st & 2nd Prize Winners from classes 88 to 92 are eligible to compete. (Dungannon & South Tyrone Borough Council Cup)

WORKING HUNTER PONIES

Entry Fee: £12 unless otherwise stated.

CLASS 94: CRADLE STARTER STAKES LEAD REIN

Mare or Gelding, 4 years old and over not exceeding 122 cms. Riders not to have attained their 10th birthday before 1st January in the current year. Jumps not exceeding 30cms. (Ponies must be led). Simple show including Walk and trot only. (Dungannon & South Tyrone Borough Council Cup)

CLASS 95: CRADLE STARTER STAKES UNLED

Mare or Gelding, 4 years old and over not exceeding 122 cms. Riders not to have attained their 10th birthday before 1st January in the current year. Jumps not exceeding 30cms. (Ponies must not be led). Simple show including Walk and trot only. (Dungannon & South Tyrone Borough Council Cup)

CLASS 96: CRADLE STARTER STAKE CHAMPIONSHIP

1st & 2nd Prize Winners from class 88 & 89 are eligible

CLASS 97: WORKING HUNTER PONIES NOT EXCEEDING 122 CMS

Riders not to have attained their 12th birthday before 1st January in the current year. Maximum height of fences 1ft 6 inches. (Dungannon & South Tyrone Borough Council Cup)

CLASS 98: WORKING HUNTER PONIES NOT EXCEEDING 133 CMS

To be ridden by a child who has not attained its 14th birthday on 1st January this year. Maximum height of fences 2ft. (Dungannon & South Tyrone Borough Council Cup)

CLASS 99: WORKING HUNTER PONIES OVER 133 CMS BUT NOT EXCEEDING 143 CM

To be ridden by a child who has not attained its 17th birthday on 1st January in the current year. (Maximum height of fences 2ft 6"). (Dungannon & South Tyrone Borough Council Cup)

CLASS 100: WORKING HUNTERS OVER 143 CMS BUT NOT EXCEEDING 153 CMS

Riders not to have attained their 25th birthday before 1st January in the current year. (Maximum height of fences 3ft) (Dungannon & South Tyrone Borough Council Cup)

CLASS 101: CHAMPIONSHIP WORKING HUNTER PONY

1st and 2nd Prize Winners from classes 94 to 100 are eligible to compete (Alan A Alcorn MBE Memorial Perpetual Cup).
